Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments*

132nd General Assembly
(S. Transportation, Commerce and Workforce)

Amendments adopted by the Senate committee make the following changes:

-- Defines "indigent" for purposes of the bill as a person who is a participant in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) administered by the Department of Job and Family Services.¹

-- Clarifies that, in order to be eligible for driver's license reinstatement fee debt reduction, at least 18 months must have expired since the *end* of an applicant's period of license suspension rather than since the court imposed the suspension as in the House-passed version.²

-- Requires a person eligible for driver's license reinstatement fee debt reduction to pay *either* the lowest reinstatement fee owed for their offenses *or* 10% of the total amount owed, whichever amount is greater, not just the lowest fee owed as in the House-passed version of the bill.³
