## S.B. 294

### **BILL SUMMARY**

• Increases the maximum amount that may be awarded under the Cleveland Scholarship Program to \$7,000 for students in all grades kindergarten through 12.

### CONTENT AND OPERATION

#### **Cleveland Scholarship Program – maximum award amount**

The bill increases the maximum amount that may be awarded under the Cleveland Scholarship Program as follows:<sup>1</sup>

Grade Level	Current Maximum	Maximum under the bill
K-8	\$4,650	\$7,000
9-12	\$6,000	\$7,000

The Cleveland Scholarship Program (officially named the Pilot Project Scholarship Program) provides scholarships to attend alternative schools, including private schools, and tutorial assistance grants to students who reside in a school district that is or has been under a federal court order for supervision and operational management by the Superintendent of Public Instruction. Currently, only the Cleveland Municipal School District meets this criterion. The program has been authorized

since 1995. It is financed partially with state funds and partially with an earmark of Cleveland's state payments.<sup>2</sup>
