Sub. Bill Comparative Synopsis

This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Topic	Previous Version (As Introduced)	Sub. Version (L_132_2455-3)
Public Employee Retirement System (PERS) service credit for certain county board of developmental disability employees	Requires, beginning on and after the bill's effective date, PERS to grant a full year of service credit to a member employed as a nonteaching school employee of a county board of developmental disabilities if the member performs full-time services for at least nine months of the year and is paid earnable salary in each month of that year and other circumstances apply (<i>R.C. 145.018</i>).	Also requires that service credit be granted in the same way for the period beginning January 1, 2017, if both of the following apply: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The member received less than a full year of service credit for employment that would have qualified the member for a full year of service credit had the bill taken effect January 1, 2017; • Not later than 90 days after the bill's effective date, the county board of developmental disabilities that employed the member during the period beginning January 1, 2017, and ending on the bill's effective date, acting through the county auditor, reports to PERS the member's name and any additional information required by PERS in the form PERS requires (<i>Section 2</i>).
